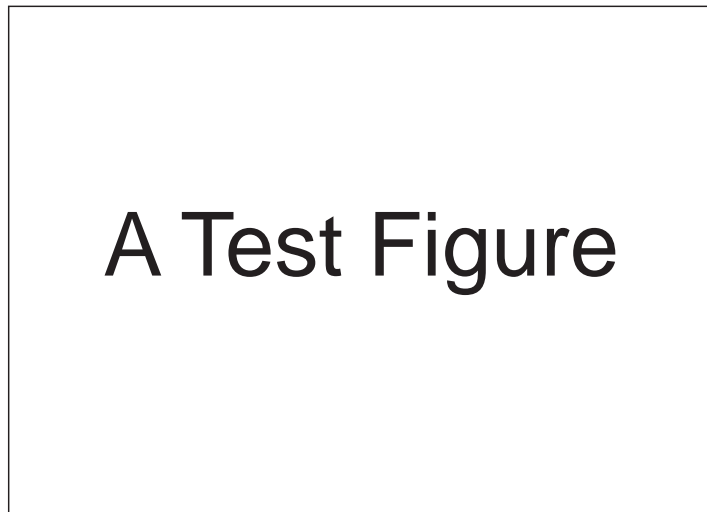


Figure 1. This is a sample figure.
